

Juneteenth Federal Holiday is on June 19th.

Juneteenth commemorates June 19, 1865, when Union soldiers brought the news of freedom to enslaved Black people in Galveston, Texas—more than two years after the Emancipation Proclamation was issued. It's the first new Federal Holiday since Martin Luther King Jr. Day was created in 1983. (Juneteenth was signed into law in 2021.)

The American Flag is a symbol of National Freedom.



The Cross is a symbol of eternal freedom. Flag Day is June 14th.
