

We are thankful to God for protecting us. Thank you, Pastor Nunes for holding our worship service on this date. Many churches decided not to hold worship services due to the predicated storm.

"News from Pastor Nunes" Ida Watson Odom, January 22, 1938-August 18, 2023



IDA WATSON ODOM was born to the late Blanche "Tan" and Katie (neé Marshall) Watson on January 22, 1938 in Buena Vista, Alabama. She was baptized at a young age at Saint James Lutheran Church in Buena Vista, AL.

Ida graduated from Monroe County Training School, Monroeville, AL (1956), Immanuel Lutheran College, Greensboro, North Carolina (1958), Barber-Scotia College, Concord, NC (1961, Bachelor of Science) and Governors State University, University Park, Illinois (1976, Master of Arts) Ida Watson married Frazier on June 12, 1960 at Saint James Lutheran Church in Buena Vista, AL. To this union were born Pamela Lareese DeLoney (Anthony) in 1961; Ina Frenae Roberson, in 1963; John Quincy Odom (Gwendolyn) in 1964; Monique Charell Nunes (John Arthur) in 1967. She is preceded in death by her dearly loved husband of 61 years, the Rev. Dr. Frazier Norton Odom (1937-2021), her sisters, Willie Clinton (1937-2015), Flora Belle Watson (1944-2017), Joe Henry Watson and Oliver Watson who

died as newborns. She is survived by her beloved sisters in mourning, Blanche (+Richard), Dickinson, Mildred (Melvin) Mobley, Helen (+Frank) Henry. "Granny" was the beloved grandmother of fourteen: Erika, Stephenie, Frenae, Mary, Antinique, Jamia, Rachel, Tiara, Monesha, Shapria, Aujunae, John, Jr., Marshand, Amir. With pride, she embraced in love her ever-expanding host of the family's great -grandchildren, nieces and nephews. A highly acclaimed educator, Mrs Odom taught at a number of public and Lutheran schools in Chicago, IL and Saint Louis, Missouri. Mama Odom actively served as the First Lady of Concordia Lutheran Church, New Orleans, Louisiana (1960-1966); Trinity Lutheran Church, Selma, AL (1966-1968); Faith Lutheran Church, Chicago, IL (1968-1986) and Transfiguration Lutheran Church, St Louis, MO (1986-2003). She was a member of the inter-Lutheran committee which led to the publication of the African American supplement for worship titled *This Far by Faith* (1999).

A devoted member of Great Commission Lutheran Church in St Louis, in later years she was also a joyful participant in the Lutheran Geriatric Adult Daycare Center community. She is remembered as an innovative and tireless church-builder. Especially young people were drawn to know the Gospel of Jesus Christ through her choirs and programs. For example, she orchestrated countless community and recreational activities, like fun-filled summer trips for urban youth to King's Island in Ohio. She cherished offering children's messages. These sometimes rivaled, in their duration and impact, the powerful sermons of her husband, Pastor Odom. When not playing the piano, Mrs Odom immersed herself in being an avid gardener, a conspicuous collector, an inventive fundraiser, and a creative chronicler of Black History, "Jesus loves the little children! All the children of the world!" The Holy Spirit chose Mama Odom to be a witness to this truth. We shall never forget her singing it enthusiastically, playing it rhythmically, praying it unceasingly, saying it passionately, sharing it inclusively, teaching it energetically, believing it everlastingly, and living it wholeheartedly in every life she touched.
